INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

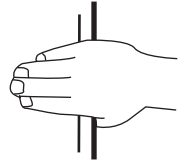
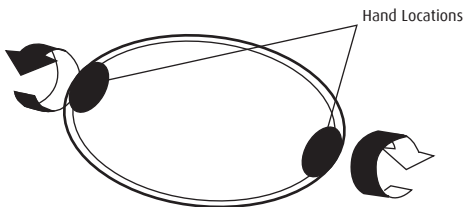
1. OPENING

Ensure that children and other persons are at a safe distance before opening.

Open the carry bag and remove the Compact Travel Bed. Undo the elastic retaining straps and steadily allow the travel bed to spring open. **Caution: The Compact Travel Bed springs open quickly. Open and fold the travel bed with extreme care, holding away from face.**

2. FOLDING & STORING

Firstly, open the top mesh panel and remove the mattress. Bring the end panels of the travel bed together. Firmly grip each end and twist in opposite directions to coil and collapse.



Grip, twist and bring hands together
(Note hand position and location)

Store all components in the carry bag to prevent loss or damage.

BAGGAGE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

To remove dirt, lightly brush with a soft brush or wet cloth using water and mild liquid soap. Do not machine wash. Do not iron. Do not bleach. Do not store when damp.

This product is not a toy; it must be handled by an adult

Keep out of reach of children when not in use

Do NOT use the travel bed near a fire and any other source of heat.

This product is made from fire resistant fabrics.
